We will learn in an environment that will be grounded in rigor, compassion, and trust. It is increasingly clear to me the rarity and importance of a learning community, engaged in embodied practices, guided by an expert facilitator in order to achieve your life goals. The Advanced Leadership Course is a Dojo that fulfills that need. **I promise you a learning experience that will take you to the next level.**

Each student will declare his or her Vision, Mission, and Project. The Vision will be what you see possible for the World; the Mission will be what you see possible in your lifetime; the Project will be what you want to accomplish in a shorter horizon of time. 87% of Strozzi Institute students have successfully accomplished their declared project.
